\$655 MILLION

HEALTH FUNDING

The 2014-15 Commonwealth Budget included a reduction of \$655 million in funding to South Australia's health system over the next four years.

\$123 MILLION

CONCESSION FUNDING

Cut to pensioner concessions of about \$30 million each year of the forward estimates.

\$47 MILLION

SKILLS FUNDING

\$38 million cut to Skills Vocational Education and Training Programs for working age people and \$9 million cut for training places for single and teenage parents.

\$73 MILLION

GONSKI PLUS OTHER FUNDING

Including \$45 million Gonski cut, \$8m to the Seamless National economy program and \$13 million repayment for Northern Expressway project completion.
